

Certification Mark in the World





The Harmonized Mark for cables.

For cables compliant with harmonized CEI standards, for cables insulated with rubber and for cables insulated with polyvinyl chloride, IMQ, the Italian Quality Mark Institute, issues the use of the harmonized HAR mark to Italian manufacturers. A cable bearing this mark is considered in all respects compliant with CEI standards and therefore subjected to the normal quality control guaranteed by IMQ and is also recognized as compliant with the national standards of the following countries: Austria, Belgium, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, United Kingdom, Hungary, Italy, Norway, Holland, Portugal, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Turkey and Hungary without further technical or administrative formalities. Furthermore, following the agreement stipulated between the certification institutes of these countries, the cables bearing the HAR mark are reported in the respective lists.

The cables that have received this certification, in addition to the stamping of the HAR mark on the outer sheath, must also bear a distinctive polyester flo with alternating colours: Black/Red/Yellow.

The HAR system is the first agreement that proposes a common marking for a specific product category that complies with the harmonized European specifications.

It is dedicated to various types of cables, enjoys a high reputation, making it a virtual standard in the European market.
