

The ENEC 03 Mark. Accompanied by the number 03, which distinguishes IMQ, the ENEC (European Norms Electrical Certification) mark certifies compliance with European safety requirements. Recognized throughout Europe as equivalent to individual national marks, ENEC can be issued for the main electrical products: lighting and emergency luminaires and related components, information technology equipment, transformers, filters, switches, control and connection devices, domestic appliances.
